

Take the DARE (Discuss, Argue, Recount, Explain). Which key use applies?


Which key use?	Example Can Do Descriptor ELLs process or produce language by:
	Sequencing events in stories or content-related processes (Reading, Grades 4-5, ELP Level 3)
	Relating details and illustrating stages of different cycles (Writing, Grades 2-3, ELP Level 4)
	Signaling agreement or disagreement of short oral statements or questions (Listening, Grades 6-8, ELP Level 1)
	Co-creating novel perspectives on issues (Oral language, Grades 9-12, ELP Level 5)
